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What are 3Rs?

The 3 R's stand for Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle, three simple but powerful ways we can help protect the environment. These actions help us cut down on the amount of waste we create and make smarter choices about how we use Earth's resources.



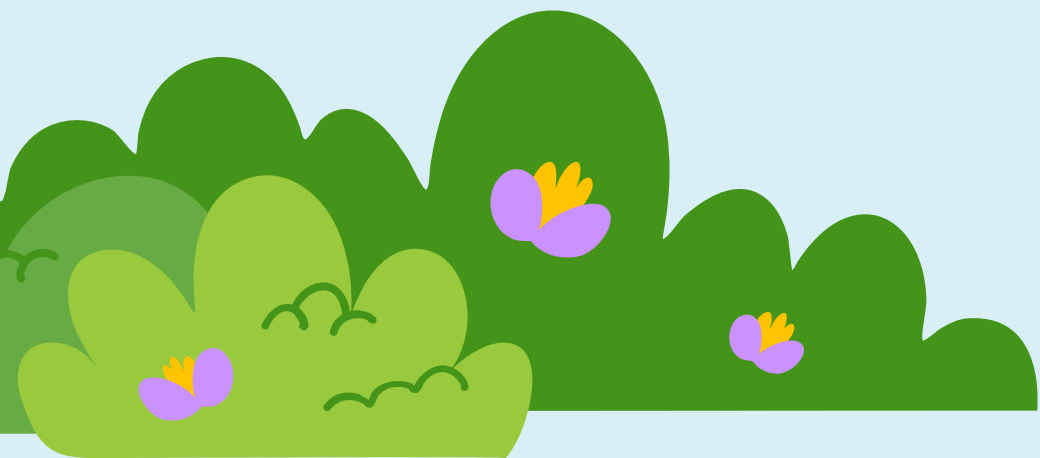
REDUCE

Reduce means using fewer resources. It's about making smart choices to avoid waste before it happens. Turning off lights, using less paper, and bringing your own water bottle are great examples.



REUSE

Reuse means using items again instead of throwing them away. This could be fixing something broken, donating clothes, or turning a jar into a pencil holder.





RECYCLE

Recycle means turning used materials into new products. Paper, plastic, metal, and glass can often be recycled instead of going to a landfill.
