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1. Design an Eco-Awareness Poster

Project Idea: Students use AI-powered design tools to create posters on environmental topics like water conservation, renewable energy, or climate change. This builds communication skills and sustainability awareness while engaging students in persuasive visual storytelling.

Suggested AI Tools: Canva, Adobe Firefly

Green Skills: Sustainability Awareness, Visual Communication, Critical Thinking



2. Create a Green Storybook

Project Idea: Learners develop an illustrated story about an environmental problem and a solution (e.g., stopping deforestation, cleaning oceans). They use ChatGPT for storytelling support and Firefly for visuals. This fosters creativity, systems thinking, and responsible citizenship.

Suggested AI Tools: ChatGPT, Adobe Firefly

Green Skills: Storytelling, Systems Thinking, Environmental Literacy



3. Sustainable City Visualization

Project Idea: Students envision future eco-friendly cities and use AI to generate images and narratives. They explore ideas like public green spaces, smart transport, and energy-efficient buildings, reflecting sector-specific green skills.

Suggested AI Tools: Adobe Firefly, DALL·E

4. Awareness Video on Climate Action

Project Idea: Students create an awareness video on issues like plastic pollution or global warming. Using Lumen5 or Synthesia, they combine data, AI narration, and visuals to convey their message effectively.

Suggested AI Tools: Lumen5, Synthesia

5. Green Innovation Project Pitch

Project Idea: Learners design an eco-innovation (e.g., compostable packaging, green energy solutions), then prepare and deliver a pitch presentation. This mirrors real-world entrepreneurship.

Suggested AI Tools: Gamma, ChatGPT

Green Skills: Problem Solving, Eco-Innovation, Communication



6. Green Week Campaign Video

Project Idea: Students create a campaign video to promote sustainability events such as tree-planting or zero-waste lunch challenges. Using avatars or text-to-speech tools, they lead peer awareness initiatives.

Suggested AI Tools: Lumen5, Synthesia, HeyGen

Green Skills: Leadership, Ethical Engagement, Advocacy



7. Sustainability Podcast

Project Idea: Students research topics like sustainable agriculture, circular economy, or clean energy and develop podcast episodes. They use Eleven Labs for narration and ChatGPT for script writing.

Suggested AI Tools: ChatGPT, Eleven Labs

8. Design a Circular Economy Infographic

Project Idea: Learners create infographics explaining how circular economy principles apply to real-world scenarios (e.g., fashion, electronics). Canva helps with layout while ChatGPT supports idea development.

Suggested AI Tools: Canva, ChatGPT

Green Skills: Circular Thinking, Visual Communication, Analysis



9. Eco-Hero Digital Comics

Project Idea: Students invent a green-themed superhero and create a comic strip that showcases challenges and sustainable solutions. This activity reinforces creative problem-solving and values-based thinking.

Suggested AI Tools: Adobe Firefly, ChatGPT

Green Skills: Creativity, Values Education, Critical Thinking



10. Design a Sustainable Product Prototype

Project Idea: Learners design and digitally prototype an eco-friendly product, explaining its impact and materials. They present their work as a slideshow or animation.

Suggested AI Tools: Gamma, Canva

11. AI-Powered Green Journalism

Project Idea: Students become school journalists covering green practices in their school or community. They generate articles and newsletters featuring interviews, statistics, and calls to action.

Suggested AI Tools: ChatGPT, Canva

12. Interactive Recycling Guide

Project Idea: Learners produce a school-based recycling guide with AI visuals and simple instructions. This promotes systems awareness and responsible behavior.

13. Sustainable Fashion Campaign

Project Idea: Students explore fast fashion's impact and promote sustainable alternatives through visual media or social posts. They create lookbooks, reels, or campaigns with AI tools.

14. Green Skills Explainer Animation

Project Idea: Learners choose one core green skill (e.g., teamwork, systems thinking) and create an animated explainer video to teach peers its value.

15. Eco-Friendly Travel Guide

Project Idea: Students research and produce an eco-travel guide including low-emission transport, responsible tourism, and carbon-saving tips.

16. Green Skill Quiz Creation

Project Idea: Learners create interactive quizzes on sustainability topics. These can be used as peer learning or awareness tools.

Suggested AI Tools: ChatGPT, Google Forms

17. Future of Food Visual Report

Project Idea: Students will investigate future trends in food production and consumption — such as plant-based diets, sustainable farming, food waste reduction, and alternative proteins. Using their research, they will create a visual report that communicates these insights through infographics, illustrated timelines, and creative visual storytelling.

Suggested AI Tools: Adobe Firefly, Canva

Green Skills: Food Systems Literacy, Communication, Innovation



18. Nature Soundboard or Audio Diary

Project Idea: Students produce a sound-based diary or calming nature soundboard with AI voices to promote mindfulness and nature appreciation.

Suggested AI Tools: Eleven Labs, Canva

Green Skills: Well-being, Environmental Connection, Digital Audio Literacy



19. Carbon Footprint Awareness Toolkit

Project Idea: Students will create a multi-platform awareness campaign to encourage their community to take small but effective actions for reducing carbon footprints. They will research key carbon reduction strategies (energy saving, sustainable mobility, waste reduction), then design engaging materials such as infographics, short videos, and social media posts.

Suggested AI Tools: Gemini, Chat GPT, Canva

Green Skills: Carbon Literacy, Action Planning, Systems Awareness



20. Green Entrepreneurship Pitch

Project Idea: Students form startup ideas that solve real-world ecological problems and develop pitches complete with logos, value propositions, and branding assets.

Suggested AI Tools: Gamma, Firefly, Canva, Gemini, ChatGPT
